All students participating in ACA sports programs are required to show proof that they have had physicals within the past twelve months and up to date immunizations.

## Required Forms:

- Completed and signed Sports Medical Release Form
- Copy of immunization record from Doctor's visit within the last 12 months
- If child carries an asthma pump, please fill out the Authorization for self-administration of medication at school and after-school activities form
- Please make coach aware of any allergies

The doctor's office can *fax* the most recent check-up including the list of all up to date immunizations to Attn: Simone Caban at (716) 564 0075.

Please mail completed sports release form and payment no later than *Monday, November 13, 2023.* Medical forms may be received after the first practice as some annual physicals are not scheduled until October. Our policy requires that a student may not participate in a game until registration and sports release form is received.

It is important that we have this information in our records to ensure the safety of the students and uphold a standard of excellence in the service we provide. We request that all students dress modestly at all practices and games. Shorts may not be more than 2 inches above the knee and form fitting. Tops should not have spaghetti straps, nor show sports bras underneath. Thank you for your help to ensure your daughter is dressed accordingly.
